

# Knife Painting in Oil Workshop taught by Michele Traum – Supply List

---

- Canvas panels or gessoed masonite (not stretched canvas) – two – sizes 9x12 or 11x14
- Oil paints: titanium white, cad yellow, cad lemon, cad red, permanent rose, permanent magenta, ultramarine blue, cerulean blue, viridian green
- Large painting palette (I use a 12x16 Masterson Stay-Wet palette with same size glass and no sponge). If you choose to not use glass, you will need palette paper.
- Painting knives –they should be tapered with a dip in the handle. See \* below for examples.
- Sketch pad – 11x14
- Pencils – 2B and Ebony
- Vine or willow charcoal
- Paper towels
- Color Wheel
- Value scale
- Wet painting carrier
